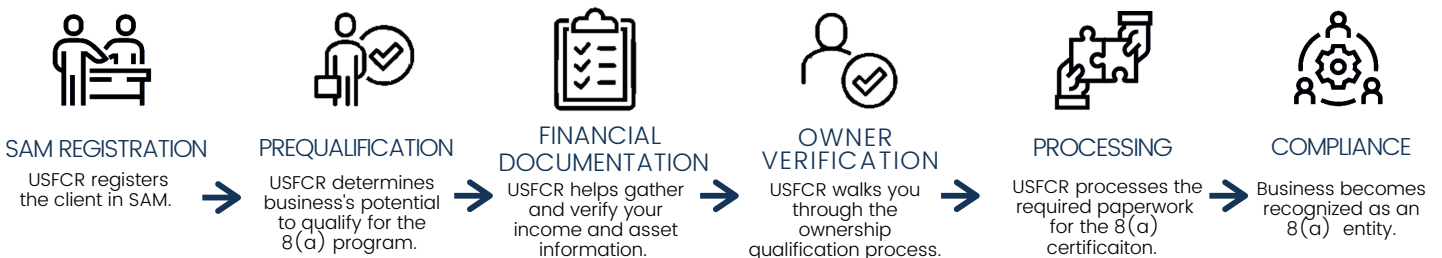
The 8(a) program requires the business owner to provide extensive documentation on their income and total assets.
